According to Law Article ex-13. 196/2003

Dear Sir / Madam,

We wish to inform you that Legislative Decree no. No 196 of June 30, 2003 ("Code regarding the protection of personal data") provides for the protection of persons and other subjects regarding the processing of personal data.

According to the law, this treatment will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights.

Under Article 13 of the law. 196/2003, we provide the following information:

1. The information you provide will be used in fulfillment of contractual obligations, accounting and tax. May be used by the sending of advertising material relating to the business relationship.
2. The data will be in the following ways: either by computer or paper support
3. Providing data is optional and the refusal to provide such data could lead to failure or partial fulfillment of the purposes mentioned above.
4. The data will not be disclosed to other parties other than our network of agents, nor will it be spread.
5. The data controller is Mr Paolo Petri
6. The controller is Mr. Paolo Petri
7. The System Administrator is Mr. Paolo Petri
8. At any time you can exercise your rights towards the data controller under Article 7 of Decree 196/2003, which we reproduced in full for your convenience:

Legislative Decree No. 196/2003, Article 7 - Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights

1. You have the right to obtain confirmation of whether or not personal data concerning him, even if not yet recorded and their communication in intelligible form.
2. You have the right to be informed:
 - a) origin of personal data;
 - b) the purposes and methods of treatment;
 - c) the logic applied in case of treatment with the aid of electronic instruments;
 - d) the identity of the owner, manager and the representative appointed under article 5, paragraph 2;
 - e) subjects or categories of persons to whom the data may be communicated or who can learn about them as appointed representative in the State, managers or agents.
3. You have the right to obtain:
 - a) updating, rectification or, when interested, integration of data;
 - b) cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed;
 - c) certification that the operations in letters a) and b) have been notified, also as regards their contents, to those to whom the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate to the protected right.
4. You have the right to oppose, in whole or in part:
 - a) for legitimate reasons the processing of personal data, pertinent to the purpose of collection;
 - b) the processing of personal data for purposes of sending advertising materials or direct selling or for carrying out market surveys or commercial communication.
